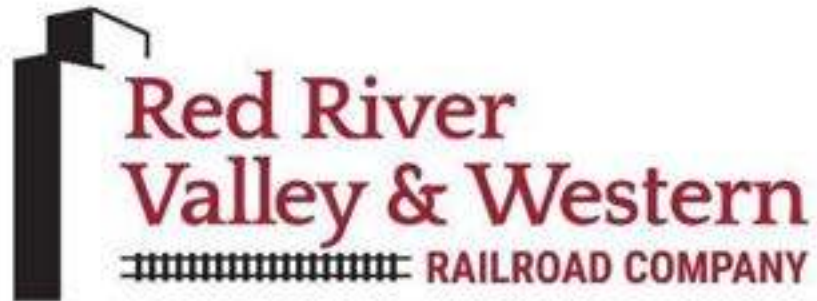

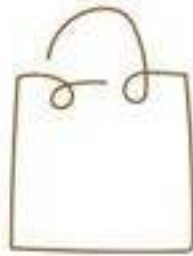

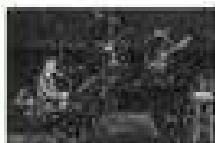

REGULATIONS

- All watercraft not registered in North Dakota must have a valid ANS sticker to be displayed on the watercraft.
- Live aquatic bait can not be transported into North Dakota.
- All bait water must be drained on shore when leaving Class 1 infested waters.
- All drain plugs that may hold back water must be removed and left out while vessel is in transport.
- All equipment must be vegetation free when in transport.

Legislative News:

[HB 1151](#) (Baiting) had a senate committee hearing on March 16th, with the committee taking no action. This bill has certainly been the most contentious outdoor bill this session, and rightfully so. This bill would strip the ND Game and Fish Department of its ability to responsibly manage our deer, moose, and elk populations for CWD. The bill has been amended to the point it is now littered with confusing language about when baiting is allowed, where it is allowed, and how much bait is allowed. The bill is bad from beginning to end and needs to be killed. At this time, we fully expect this bill will get a Do Pass recommendation from the committee. So please, keep putting pressure on your district senators to VOTE NO on HB 1151.

[HB 1538](#) (Fishing Contest) also had a senate committee hearing on March 16th, with no action taken. Again, the issue with this bill is the elimination of the conservation fee for pro-angler tournaments in ND. At this time, we feel the odds are good the committee will give a DO NOT PASS recommendation, but that means very little when it comes time for the senate to vote. Again, keep putting pressure on your district senator to VOTE NO on HB 1538.

All bills must be out of committee by Thursday, March 30th. At that point they will be scheduled for the Senate Floor for a vote. So, it's important that you make your voice heard now.
