### *Annual Meeting and Chalkfest*

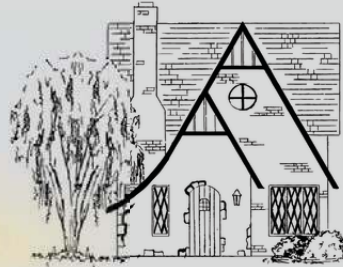

City of Wahpeton Police Supporters:

The Wahpeton Police Department is looking to reestablish the K9 program. In the past this program has had great success in the abilities of locating illegal drugs, collecting evidence and assisting in locating missing persons. The ability to use this asset and welcome a new member to the Wahpeton Police Department is invaluable.

Historically the city of Wahpeton has had a number of K9's that have served our well-loved community, and proved their worth amongst the citizens and the Wahpeton Police Department.

At this time, we are asking for your help in funding the purchase of a K9, training for the K9 as well as its handler, and all necessary equipment to be operational.

The cost of starting a program such as this is estimated to be between \$20,000-\$25,000.

The K9 can be utilized in many ways:

- **School programs**: Not only can we reduce drugs in our local schools, but also keep them out. An added benefit comes from having contact with the children in our community and building a relationship with Law Enforcement.
- **Narcotics detection**: The K9 will be trained in detection of illegal narcotic odors which helps officers locate hidden drugs, arrest suspects, and keep illegal drugs off our streets.
- **Tracking and training**: Our K9 will be trained to search for individuals. This can be criminals who ran on foot or even missing or lost adults and children. The K9 can accomplish this even after hours have passed since the person went missing.
- **Evidence collection**: Our K9 will be able to detect human scent on evidence that is discarded by suspects during criminal activities that can lead us to a suspect.

As shown above, the K9 program is a valuable part of our overall response to keeping our citizens safe, as well as a positive influence for our schools.

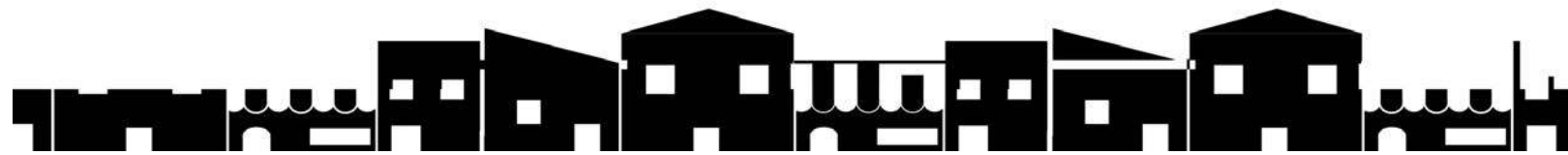

Transportation is a significant barrier for individuals in rural communities, and our service helps meet the high demand for transportation in our area.

# *Group Workcamp 2022*

## *June 19th - June 25th*

Lakes & Prairies Community Action Partnership (CAPLP) is teaming up with Group Workcamps to help improve homes within 30 miles of Moorhead, Minnesota June 19-25, 2022. We are reaching out to older adults, persons with disabilities, single parents, and income eligible residents. We are excited to transform homes and create better living conditions for the families we serve! Hundreds of youth from across America will come together for five days to repair and transform homes while strengthening and transforming their own faith.

Each home site will consist of 4-5 senior high youth and at least one adult leader. Site writers will visit your home prior to the Group Workcamp and help with identifying repairs and materials needed for your specific project. **Eligible households must be within 30 miles driving distance of Moorhead, MN (Homes must be located in MN)**. Eligible repairs are “basic” home repair and are listed with this application.

**Both labor and materials will be free to qualifying households.** Work will be done by youth volunteers. Households receiving assistance must agree to provide water, electricity for tools, a restroom for the volunteers as well as providing an adult in the home the week of the repairs.
